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PRIORITIES FOR INVESTMENT

REVOLUTIONIZING BIOLOGY AND TECHNOLOGY

We are at a transitional moment in our understanding of human biology, akin to the scientific revolution that gave rise to modern physics. High-performance computing, artificial intelligence, deep machine learning, and data science at both the molecular and clinical level will change how we conduct research, practice medicine, and keep people healthier in the face of the most pressing diseases.

IMPLEMENTING NEW MODELS OF CARE

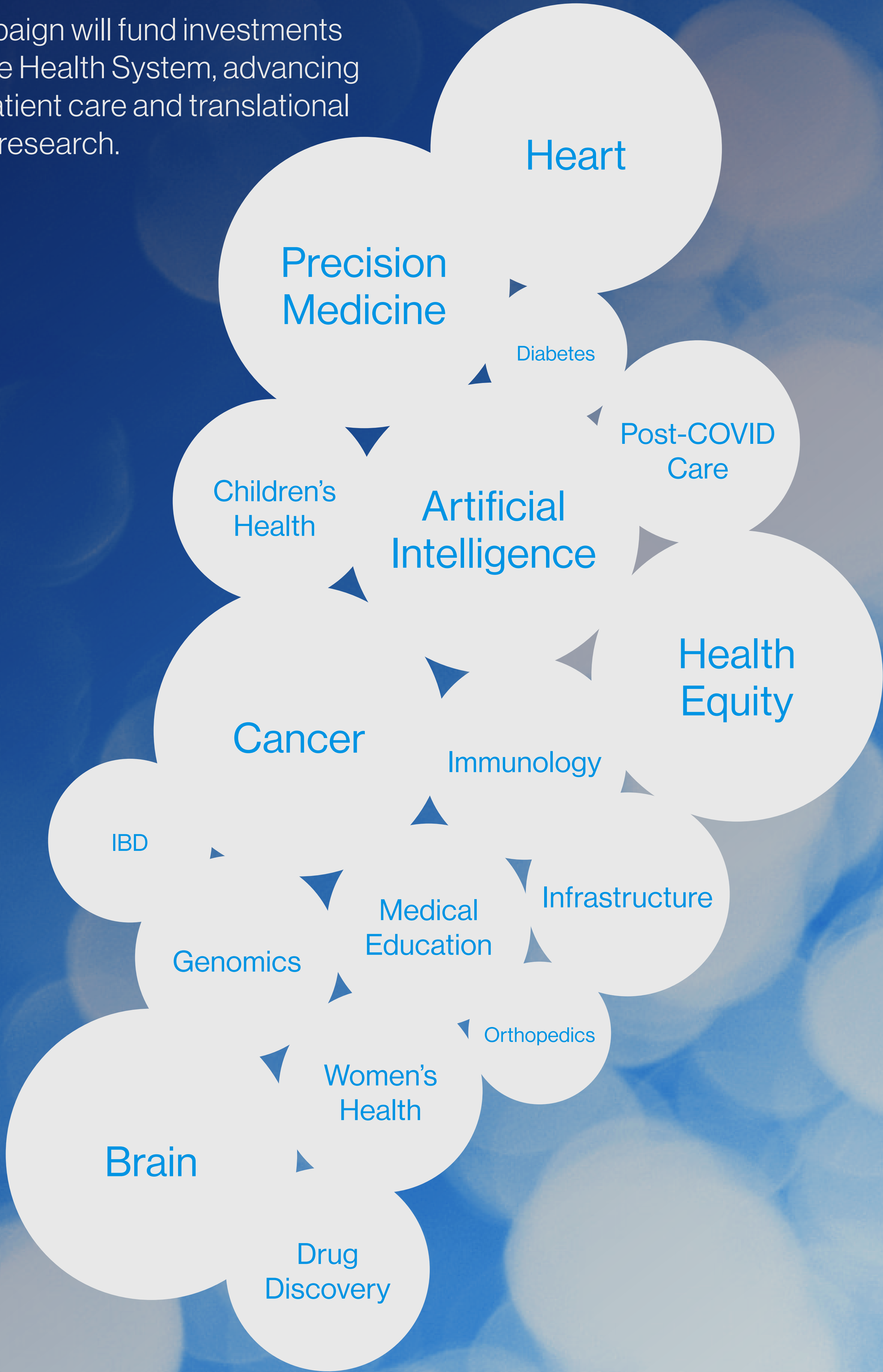
